The Vestibule: Please note that the vestibule is reserved for nursing mothers. Please avoid congregating in the vestibule during Mass. If you are late to Mass please find your way into the pews quickly and quietly so as not to disturb those around you and please do not loiter in the vestibule.

Epiphany Water: Epiphany water is available from the vestibule.

Parish Financial Update: A comparison with last years income shows that ordinary income (collects) is up by \$1,530.00 compared with this time last year. Thank you for your generosity. However the overall expenditure for the period July—Dec has also increased by \$1,676.00 due to necessary boiler maintenance in the church. At this time the increase in collections DOES NOT justify the assignment of another priest to St. Michaels.

Young Recusants

The term Recusant, which derives ultimately from the Latin *recusare* (to refuse or make an objection) was first used to refer to those who remained loyal to the Pope and the Roman Catholic Church and who did not attend Church of England services at the time of Queen Elizabeth I. Although William Shakespeare (1564-1616) and his immediate family were conforming members of the established Church of England, Shakespeare's mother, Mary Arden, was a member of a particularly conspicuous and determinedly Catholic family in Warwickshire. Some scholars also believe there is evidence that several members of Shakespeare's family were secretly recusant Catholics. The strongest evidence is a tract professing secret Catholicism signed by John Shakespeare, father of the poet. Recusants and martyrs are represented in the Forty Martyrs of England and Wales and among the Jacobites, such as the Earls of Derwentwater, particularly those ennobled in the Jacobite Peerage.
