Mass Intention Book: The Mass intention book is now open. If you wish to have Masses said for friends, family or any other intention please remember the Dioceses suggested stipend is \$10. Mass intentions can be made directly through the pastor during office hours or via the collection basket. Please include your name on the request as well as the intended.

Easter Vigil: While the 1982 Code of Canon Law permits for any Mass after 4pm on Saturday to supply for the Sunday obligation the Pastor reminds those regularly attending St. Michael's that the traditional Easter Vigil is not considered a Mass of anticipation and is therefore a unique liturgical event which should not preclude attendance at Mass on Easter Sunday.

Confession during Holy Week & Easter Duty: The Pastor takes this opportunity to remind you of your Easter Duty. The Easter duty is the obligation to receive Holy Communion. It is required by canon 920: "§1. After being initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, each of the faithful is obliged to receive Holy Communion at least once a year. §2. This precept must be fulfilled during the Easter season unless it is fulfilled for a just cause at another time during the year." The obligated to go to confession is related in the sense that, in order to receive Holy Communion, one might need to go to confession first in order to be in a state of grace. Easter season is the period between the 1st Sunday of Lent and Trinity Sunday. Assuming regular attendance at St. Michaels and the frequent reception of Holy Communion it is not necessary therefore to make a confession during this period. You may however take the opportunity to prepare for Easter with a good sacramental confession mindful of the schedule given below.

Palm Sunday:	Confession from 8:30am; Solemn High Mass at 9:30am
Monday 26th March:	Confession from 6:00pm; Solemn High Mass at 7:00pm
Tuesday 27th March:	Confession from 6:00pm; Solemn High Mass at 7:00pm
Wednesday 28th March:	Confession from 6:00pm; Solemn High Mass at 7:00pm
Holy Thursday:	Solemn High Mass at 7:00pm with Adoration till Midnight
Good Friday:	Stations at 2:00pm, Mass of the Pre-sanctified at 3:00pm
Easter Vigil:	Blessing of New Fire at 7:30pm followed by Vigil Mass
