The Vestibule: Please note that the vestibule is reserved for nursing mothers. Please avoid congregating in the vestibule during Mass. If you are late to Mass please find your way into the pews quickly and quietly so as not to disturb those around you and please do not loiter in the vestibule.

Secret Santa: Please remember to place your Secret Santa gifts under the Christmas tree before the 10:15am Mass on 6th January. The Pastor will distribute gifts after the High Mass. Secret Santa at 11:30am, Pot Luck from 11:45am, Christmas Pageant at 12:30am.

Epiphany Water: Epiphany water is available from the vestibule.

Epiphany Blessings: A traditional way of doing this is to use chalk to write above the home's entrance, 20 + C + M + B + 19. The letters C, M, B have two meanings. They are the initials of the traditional names of the three magi: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar. They also abbreviate the Latin words *Christus mansionem benedicat*, "May Christ bless the house." The "+" signs represent the cross and 2019 is the year. Blessed Chalk is available in the vestibule. Please only take a small piece.
