**Diocesan Annual Appeal Update:** The Diocesan Annual Appeal has begun. Our parish target this year is \$10,000. So far we have raised only \$3,300 from 23 Parishioners. The average gift is therefore is \$143.00. There are more than 23 families registered at St Michaels.

If you have not received a Diocesan Appeal Envelope in the mail or your name is not included with the envelopes at the back of the church, please take one from the Appeal Display. Our Parish Number is #60. Please give generously. In pew envelopes are at the back of the Church with your name on them. Extra envelope are also available in the Appeal Display.

There is a considerable way to go to meet our target for this years Diocesan Appeal. A failure to meet the target will result in the difference being removed from our parish account. The average Sunday collection for St. Michaels is between \$2,500—\$3,000. Therefore the outstanding Appeal total is equivalent to the average Sunday collection for two or three weeks. The parish can not easily afford to lose two weeks of collections and maintain a reasonable balance for repairs, maintenance and improvements. ### Announcements

**Pastor on Retreat:** The Pastor will be on retreat until Friday 17th November. In his absence Fr. Saguto will be covering Sunday and daily Masses. Normal service will be resumed on Friday 17th with Exposition and Benediction before Mass at 6pm.

**Parish Envelops:** The parish envelop system is an invaluable means by which to reward the giver, acknowledge historic gifts, and keep track of parish participation. As we get closer to the new calendar year the Pastor will be reviewing the giving records in order to determine the number of active parishioners and update the parish role.

Also it is frequently brought to the Pastors attention that from time to time the amount entered on the parish giving envelop differs from that of the enclosed gift, or even that there is no gift included. Please therefore make sure that when using a parish giving envelop you take the time to enter and enclose the correct intended amount.
