However as we are a parish attached to the Traditional Latin Mass the Pastor suggests that you make a special effort to observe the 1962 practices. These are hallowed by time and custom and can be found in the FSSP Calendar and Liturgical Ordo both of which are available from Fraternity Publications.

Stations of the Cross: Every Friday during Lent beginning at 5:00pm followed by the Rosary and Mass at 6pm.

40 Hours Devotion: This devotion marks the customary beginning of Lent. This year however the parish will host its 40hour Devotion to the Blessed Sacrament beginning at 4pm on Friday 9th March through to 8am on Sunday 11th March. It is required that at least two people be in attendance with the Blessed Sacrament at all times during the Devotion. A sign up sheet has been placed in the vestibule. **Unless all the spots can be filled before Sunday 4th March we will not be able to proceed with the Devotion.** Therefore please consider carefully your duty to pray for the members of the parish both living and dead and offer yourself to spend an hour with Christ this year in preparation of His Passion, Death and Resurrection.
