His talk will begin after Mass and conclude with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament and Veneration of the Holy Relics of St. Padre Pio. Please bring a breakfast item to share.

**Parking:** Please be considerate when parking in front of the Church. Pull up to the STOP sign or the car in front please don't leave space. **Stations of the Cross:** Every Friday during Lent beginning at 5:00pm followed by the Rosary and Mass at 6pm.

**40 Hours Devotion:** This devotion marks the customary beginning of Lent. This year however the parish will host its 40hour Devotion to the Blessed Sacrament beginning at 4pm on Friday 9th March through to 8am on Sunday 11th March. It is required that at least two people be in attendance with the Blessed Sacrament at all times during the Devotion. A sign up sheet has been placed in the vestibule. **Unless all the spots can be filled before Sunday 4th March we will not be able to proceed with the Devotion.** Therefore please consider carefully your duty to pray for the members of the parish both living and dead and offer yourself to spend an hour with Christ this year in preparation of His Passion, Death and Resurrection.
