As we approach the end of my first year as Pastor it behooves me to carry out some necessary house-keeping. As you will no doubt recall there were a number of parish envelops uncollected early this year. This indicates that the number of actual attendees at St. Michaels is likely to be very different from that contained in the parish register. Moreover a close examination of our parish database shows that the data we have is based only on giving record and not on parish attendance. This means that we have no easy means to determine who is an actual parishioner versus a casual visitor, and that new parishioners can not be easily added. It also means that in many cases our data is largely out of date.

Therefore I propose to hold a parish census during the month of May and ask all regular attendees to re-register themselves and/or their families using the census cards provided in the vestibule (one per household). Please return the cards in the collection basket before 31 May 2018. Your information will be used for Parish purposes only and will not be shared with other third parties.

The faculties granted to the FSSP by the Diocese limit your Pastors ability to provide the sacraments to you. Therefore only those who have completed a census card will be considered eligible to receive pastoral ministry by right as of June 2018. Therefore please ensure that you complete a census form and return it to the parish office before the due date. All new parishioners are also asked to complete the census form before considering themselves members of St. Michaels parish. If you are not a registered parishioner you may not be eligible to receive pastoral care from the FSSP.
