Mass Intention Book: The Mass intention book is now closed.

Feast of St. Michael the Archangel: The patronal feast of the parish will be celebrated on Saturday 29th September with the High Mass at 9:00am following the usual holy hour from 8:00am. Afterwards parishioners are invited take pot luck in the hall. Please contact Mrs. Joyce Kiefer for details of what items to bring.

Parish finances: After many enquiries regarding the financial cost of securing a second priest for the parish of St. Michaels the pastor wishes to address the subject. The Diocesan Compensation rate for a Parochial Vicar is calculated as \$31,140/year. The total income of the Parish is on average \$182,000/year. The total expenditure is averaged as \$180,000/year. This expense includes a contribution to the FSSP of \$30,352/year for one priest (94% of the actual rate for a Pastor). If the parish is to receive a Parochial Vicar it is clear that the annual income must increase by at least \$30,000/year. This is equivalent to an additional \$625/week. With our parish census now completed the pastor can report that the number of adults members of St. Michaels is 161. To secure the necessary increase to allow the parish to afford a Parochial Vicar it would be necessary for every member to increase their contribution by \$4/week. Since it is not always possible for everyone to increase their contribution if you can increase your contribution by just \$20/month it might make all the difference.
